The Consortium for Illinois Learning Communities (CILC) invites faculty, staff, and administrators involved with or interested in establishing learning communities (LCs) at two- and four-year colleges/universities from across the country to submit proposals for sessions focusing on innovative course offerings, programs, pedagogies, and assessment efforts. Sessions should contain interactive elements between presenters and audience members and should be no longer than 75 minutes.

Session Proposal categories will include, but are not limited to:

- **Institutional LC Efforts** (Why/how those efforts started; Where are those efforts now? Lessons learned?)
- **Generating Faculty Involvement** (Why did faculty get involved? Current faculty involvement—why did they stay/not stay involved? Lessons learned?)
- **Designing LC Courses** (Creating the original design; Evolution of the LC over time. Lessons Learned?)
- **Outreach Efforts** (Strategies used to recruit students—what’s worked, what hasn’t. Lessons learned?)
- **Assessment Efforts** (How have you measured the successes of your LCs? Lessons learned?)
